

Technology Acceptable Use Agreement

Technology resources such as computers are provided for educational purposes only. This means that computers are to be used only for class assignments and research when granted permission and supervised by a staff member.

Logging into another person's network account is prohibited and sharing information and passwords is unacceptable. You are responsible for the security of your network account and will be held accountable for any activity in your account.

Playing games, downloading files from the Internet, loading software, emailing and instant messaging are strictly banned. Do not share your work unless you are working on a group project as assigned by your teacher.

Students: it is your responsibility to check your computer and notify your teacher immediately if there are any problems with the computer. Any attempt to harm the computer or the network is prohibited.

All users are expected to follow existing copyright laws.
