**Team Managers**, please inform your players (and ask them to inform their spectators) of the following facility rules.

## HERITAGE YARDS AT PLANO, TEXAS FACILITY RULES

1. All fields are for games only and practices are not allowed. Teams must warm up in designated fenced areas. Players will not be allowed to throw or to bat in spectator/pedestrian areas.
2. Teams may not hit or throw balls into any fences during warm-ups.
3. Teams are responsible for cleaning their dugouts after each game. Leaving a dirty dugout is a litter violation and is not appreciated by the next team occupying the dugout. Please take a couple of minutes to clean up the dugout for the next team's use.
4. Heritage Yards is a non-smoking/non-tobacco facility. Players, spectators, or officials may be asked to leave the park or be cited for violation of City ordinance if not in compliance. This **includes** the dugouts.
5. Players must be in the dugouts at all times unless playing defense, batting, coaching first or third base, or warming up in the warm-up circle.
6. Alcohol is not allowed in the park, **including** the parking lot. Players, spectators, or officials may be asked to leave the park or be cited for violation of City ordinance if not in compliance.
7. Skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, bicycles, scooters, or activities deemed to conflict with the scheduled programming of the park site are not allowed inside the gates due to spectator/pedestrian safety. "Wall ball" and other similar activities are also not allowed due to safety and facility concerns.
8. The use of sidewalk chalk is not permitted on sidewalks, any concrete areas, or any Heritage Yards structures.
9. All animals must be on a leash not to exceed 48 inches in length and must be under the control of the owner at all times. Pets may not be left tied to the fence. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their animals at all times.
10. Glass containers are not allowed in the park.
11. The park is not responsible for items left or lost by the teams and their spectators.
12. Heritage Yards is a family-oriented softball facility. Appropriate behavior and language is necessary at all times.
