

Round Table

1. Teacher poses a problem/question that has multiple answers. (For example, the planets in the solar system, everything we learned about adaptations, etc.)
2. Students each write a response.
3. When cued, each student passes his response sheet/card to the person on his/her right. That person reads what has been written by the previous person and adds his/her response. This continues around the table until the teacher calls a halt to the activity.

In Share Around:

1. Teacher poses a problem/question that has multiple answers.
2. Students take turns sharing the answers as in Round Table, but this time, they do it orally. This is useful when needing students to participate.

Hints:

Be sure the question is open ended enough that there will be many responses.
