

This program adds 4 additional fonts to word processing programs: DN Manuscript, DN Cursive, ZB Manuscript, and ZB Cursive. The Handwriting Install icon is used 1 time to install the fonts.

Install the fonts (1 time):


- Click on the Handwriting Install icon found in the Language Arts folder.
- Reboot the computer.
 - You will not see anything happen, but the 4 fonts will appear in the font list within word processing programs, etc. after you reboot the computer.

Produce documents using these fonts:

Manuscript Fonts

- In *Word* select one of the handwriting fonts--DN Manuscript, for example--before keying in the text. OR
- Create the document, select all or part of the text, and change the selection to the handwriting font of choice.

Cursive Fonts

- In *Word* select DN Cursive or ZB Cursive font and type the document.
 - Notice that the letters do not connect and are difficult to read--especially "o" and "v."
 - Highlight (CTRL A for whole document) all DN or ZB text and CUT.
 - Maximize the Applications Window (Plano ISD... on bottom Task Bar)
 - Double click on LinkLetter DN or LinkLetter ZB icon in Language Arts folder. (You will not notice anything happening.)
 - Click on  (on bottom Task Bar) to return to your document.
 - Paste text back into document (quick keys = CTRL V). Letters will be connected
- * To disconnect the letters, follow the steps above but click the LinkLetter Undo icons.
