

Dismissal Procedures New for 2009-2010

Student safety is our primary goal at arrival and dismissal. These new procedures have been developed to keep students safe, and to create an efficient flow of traffic around campus. Your patience is appreciated as we all learn new routines.

Carpool

- Teachers will use walkie-talkies to call students.
- Staff members will call student last names and grade levels from pink cards in the front windshield.
- K-1 students and their older siblings use the K-1 carpool lane. Students wait in the 1st grade hallway.
- Grade level teachers (2nd-5th) will walk older siblings to the 1st grade hallway.
- 2nd-5th students will use the front carpool lane.
- Staff will only use the walkie-talkies to call students in the carpool lane.
- (see **Walkers**)

Walkers

- Students who walk home, or are picked up by walking parents, will be dismissed and supervised by grade level teachers.
- Parents can meet their students where the grade level dismisses. (**see map**)
- Older siblings may walk outside to meet younger siblings.
- Parents should meet younger students first.

Note that teachers on duty with Walkers do not have walkie-talkies. Parents must send a note to school if there is a change in dismissal, as a student waiting with Walkers will not hear his/her name called from the Carpool line.

Bus

- PISD buses and Day Care buses/vans will pick up students in the bus lane.
- Grade level teachers will walk the students to the bus lane and supervise the loading of buses.

PASAR

Students will be walked to the gym by a grade level teacher and supervised by PASAR staff.
