

- **Beach Ball Math (beach ball, black marker)**
 - With a black marker, draw lines on a beach ball. Separate each colored section into two or three more sections. In each section, write a number 0-12. Throw the ball with a friend or family member. When you catch the ball, look at the numbers where your thumbs are located. Multiply those two numbers and throw the ball back to your partner.

- **Newspaper Math (newspaper, scissors, glue, paper)**
 - Look through a newspaper and cut out as many numbers as you can find. Glue the numbers on a piece of paper and insert multiplication/division symbols to create equations.

- **Bag It (paper bag & index cards, construction paper, or deck of cards)**
 - Get a lunch bag. Drop in two sets of cards numbered 0-12. Draw two cards and perform the chosen operation.

- **Domino Drills (dominoes)**
 - Play the traditional game, but each time someone plays a domino, he or she must multiply the dots on the dominoes.
