

Spelling Homework Helper

1. Making spelling words out of cookie dough or clay.
2. Watercolor spelling words on paper or sidewalk.
3. Chalk talk - use sidewalk chalk to practice spelling words.
4. Practice Spelling Words on a chalkboard or dry erase board.
5. Put hair gel or paint inside of a zip-lock bag and practice writing words on it. You could also practice b's, d's, p's and q's the same way.
6. Practice writing spelling words in sand or salt.
7. Write spelling words on a small piece of construction paper. They can be written, painted, or written with letter stamps. A colorful border could be made around the word.
8. Use magnetic letters on cookie sheet to spell words.
9. Use cereal or other small snack foods to make spelling words.
10. Make a collage of spelling words. Use magazines or newspapers.
11. Make word search puzzles with weekly spelling list.

16. Type your words on the computer in a fun font and color.
17. Delicious words - write all of your words using whipped cream, peanut butter, etc...
18. Play catch with a family member - throw a ball back and forth each time saying a letter.
19. Write Spelling words 3 times. Then circle your neatest one.
20. Use Legos or blocks to build words.
