

EXEMPTIONS FOR SECOND SEMESTER SENIORS



***In order for a senior to qualify for exemptions from the final exam during the second semester, he /she must meet the following criteria:**

- **The student shall have an average of at least an 85 for the second semester (per class).**
- **The student must have at least an 85 average for the final grading period – 6th six weeks (per class).**
- **The student shall not have any unexcused absences and no more than three (3) excused absences for the semester (per class).**
- **The student must have no more than five (5) tardies (per class).**
- **Placement in suspension, i.e., in-school suspension, home suspension or expulsion for any period of time will disqualify the student from the exemption process.**
- **Students must have no outstanding fines, fees or owe for school property.**
- **The student must report to class for attendance accounting and check out requirements at the start of the first exam day to be exempt from taking any exam day will result in a zero as the grade for the examination. If the student has a pass for an excused absence, he/she will be allowed to take the make-up examination on the schedule date.**
