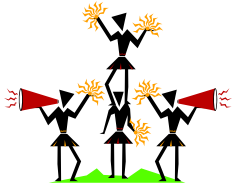
CHEERLEADING

The Speech & Drama club for Wilson, which supports Wilson MS plays & speech tournaments.

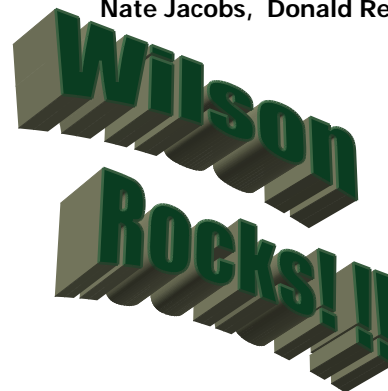
Meets monthly after school— meeting days vary.

Open to all interested students.

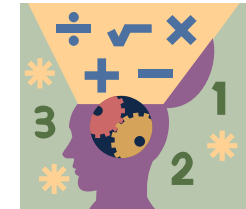
